SPLENDOUR TIPS

HERE ARE SOME IMPORTANT POINTERS TO HELP YOU (AND OTHERS) ENJOY YOUR TIME AT SPLENDOUR IN THE GRASS 2012.

- Respect the local community and environment.
- If walking, please keep the noise down in residential areas.
- Use your accommodation as a place to sleep, NOT to party. Complaints may lead to you being evicted from your accommodation with no refund.
- Do not litter – use trash cans or hold onto it until you find a bin. At the festival, there are separate bins for rubbish and recyclables. Please use the correct bin.
- Avoid the centre of town late at night – there isn't much open and taxis are in short supply.
- Please use the shuttle buses provided by Splendour. They are the fastest and safest way to travel to and from the event.
- Please use public toilets. If you do walk to and from the festival, plan ahead so you don't get caught short.
- Prepare to be searched upon entry (including bags). Unfortunately we need to do this and your co-operation is appreciated
- To report LOST and FOUND articles, please go to the INQUIRIES booth located at the northern end of the event area near the Forum.
- Items you can't take into the event: Glass, cans, alcohol, illicit drugs, skateboards, boogie boards, plastic crates, chairs, anything studded, weapons or any other items considered illegal or dangerous, fireworks, professional video & tape recording devices, professional still cameras, laser lights, umbrellas, water pistols, glow sticks, animals.
- Please remember to drink lots of water throughout the day. Sealed plastic (no glass) bottles of water or soft drink can be brought into the event. You can also get water from taps on site or in bars (see map).
- First aid services: Emergency First Aid and chill out station crowd carers will be on site for the duration of the event. If you require assistance refer to the map for locations.
- Footwear required. Bare feet and thongs waste too much of our first aid team's time. Wear proper shoes/boots.
- Drink responsibly. People who are unduly intoxicated will not be served alcohol and will be removed from the event.
- Look out for your friends and fellow punters.
- Do not remove your wristband.
- Stage diving, crowd surfing and moshing are prohibited. Any patron caught practising this behaviour risks eviction from the site.
- Police will be present at the event. Drug detection dogs will also be in attendance. Radar patrols and breath-testing and drug-testing will be in operation.
- Splendour's ECO COPS will also be on patrol making sure that everyone is showing proper respect to the environment by not doing environmentally dodgy things such as peeing in the bushes, throwing ciggie butts on the ground or dropping food in recyclables bins.
- Smokers please use the ciggie butt bins which will also be handed out by the Eco Cops.
- Travel safely. On the highway, take regular breaks and don't drive if you're tired or intoxicated. Organise a designated driver.
- **BIN IT!** Help keep your festival, Byron Bay and other nearby towns litter free!
